South Bend, an All-American City, is the hub of a multi-county, bi-state region. It is the fourth largest city in Indiana with a population of 104,905. The city of Mishawaka has 48,912 residents. St. Joseph County has a total population of 267,613, which includes 101,237 households. The immediate eight-county region has 936,507 residents, while the greater Michiana region boasts more than 1.84 million people within a 60 minute drive time of South Bend/Mishawaka.

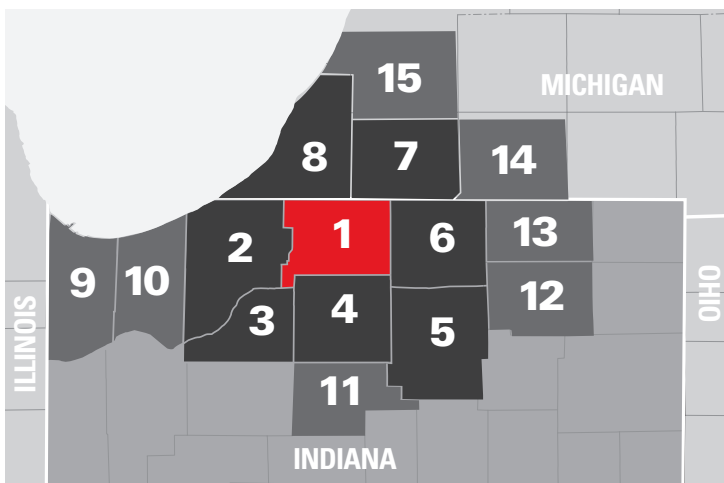
